2. A person can act as a proxy on behalf of members not exceeding fifty and holding in the aggregate not more than ten percent of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights. A member holding more than ten percent of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy provided such person shall not act as a proxy for any other person or shareholder. The Proxy form duly completed must reach the Registered Office of the Company not later than forty eight hours before the time of holding the meeting. Members/Proxies should bring duly filled in and signed Attendance Slip sent herewith for attending the Meeting. The Members holding shares in de-materialized form are requested to bring their Client ID and DP ID for easy identification of attendance at the Meeting.
3. The Registers of Members and Share Transfers shall remain closed from Thursday, the 24th Day of September, 2026 to Wednesday, the 30th Day of September, 2026 [both days inclusive] and the cut- off date is 23rd Day of September, 2026.
4. Members holding shares in dematerialization form are hereby informed that the Company or its Registrar cannot act on any request received directly from the Members holding shares in dematerialization form for any change in bank particulars. Such changes are to be intimated only to the Depository Participants of the Members. Members holding shares in demat form are requested to intimate any change in their address and / or bank mandate immediately to their Depository Participants.
5. Pursuant to Section 72 of the Companies Act, 2013, Members who hold shares in the physical form can nominate a person in respect of all the shares held by them singly or jointly. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / list of Beneficial Owners as on Wednesday, 23rd September, 2026, i.e. Cut off date, the date prior to the commencement of book closure, are entitled to vote on the Resolutions set forth in this Notice. The members may cast their votes on electronic voting system from place other than the venue of the meeting (remote e-voting). The remote e-voting period will commence on Sunday, 27th September, 2026 (09:00 A.M IST) and ends on Tuesday, 29th September, 2026 (05:00 P.M IST). In addition, the facility for voting through Ballot shall be made available at the AGM and the Members attending the AGM who have not cast their vote by remote e-voting shall be eligible to vote at the AGM. The Company has appointed CS Debabrata Deb Nath, Partner of R & D Company Secretaries, Practicing Company Secretary (FCS:7775; CP:8612), to scrutinize the entire voting process in a fair and transparent manner. **The Members desiring to vote through remote e-voting are requested to refer to the detailed procedure given hereinafter Annexure A.**

14. Pursuant to the prohibition imposed vide Secretarial Standard on General Meetings (SS-2) issued by the ICSI and the MCA circular, no gifts/coupons shall be distributed at the Meeting.

The registers of directors and Key Managerial Personnel and their Shareholding maintained under section 170 of the Companies Act, 2013, the register of contracts or arrangements in which directors are interested under section 189 of the Companies Act, 2013 will remain available for inspection at Annual General Meeting.

THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

Step 2 : Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode.

- (i) The voting period begins on Sunday, 27th September, 2026 (09:00 A.M IST) and ends on Tuesday, 29th September, 2026(05:00 P.M IST). During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of 23rd September, 2026 may cast their vote electronically. The Remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

(i) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

Pursuant to above said SEBI Circular, Login method for e-Voting **for Individual shareholders holding securities in Demat mode CDSL/NSDL** is given below:
